Be More retreat format is divided into two sections: Theology and Life Skills Lessons. The Theology lessons will dive deep into the Sacrament of Marriage, the Grace of the sacrament and Church teaching in regards to marriage. The Life Skills lessons offer guidance and experience in various aspects of marriage and family life.

We encourage you to invite other couples to join you for your retreat experience- mentor couple, other engaged couples, family members, etc. Please complete the retreat at your own pace and do not rush through the lessons. *Be More* is an opportunity to address topics and have intimate conversations with your beloved that will bear fruit for years to come.

Theology Lesson 1-6:

- Theology Lesson 1: Belong- God's Image and Likeness and Being in Relationship Ryan and Mary Rose Verret unpack what marriage is and encourage you to discover the importance of growing in your marriage with other couples as one of the most important things you can do. When we are connected to each other, we grow as persons, as a couple and in community with other couples. Take the time to discover the art of relationship and cultivate a true sense of belonging. Remember that God is calling you, not to do more, but to be more.

- Theology Lesson 2: Believe- The Grace of the Sacrament In this session, Fr. Ben Tran uncovers the beauty of the Grace of the Sacrament of Marriage. The Sacrament of Marriage is a supernatural calling by God for couples to strive to live holy, permanent, fruitful and life long marriages. The role of husband and wife in a marriage is to help one another on this pilgrimage through life to get to heaven.

- Life Skills Lesson 1: Self Knowledge Tony and Liz Cotrupi will cover the topic of Self Knowledge, including: Giving of yourself to someone in marriage; Need to become more self aware to be able to live out your vows; Appreciate similarities and differences to grow in intimacy; We are a combination of nature, nurture, and true self.

- Life Skills Lesson 2: Communication in Marriage How a husband and wife communicate with each other (verbally & non-verbally) is critical in marriage. Positive communication can benefit a couple in many ways including strengthening their relationship, aiding in decision making, and fostering intimacy. During this talk, Craig & Stephanie Rapp share an overview of what they have learned about communication in their marriage and offer their top five tips for couples to communicate effectively.

- Life Skills Lesson 4: Finances Finances are a normal and natural challenge in a marriage. Deacon Eric and Linda Paige will explore how we use the gifts God has given us through the lens of the four Cardinal Virtues, habits that help us make good decisions- Prudence, Justice, Fortitude and Temperance.

- Life Skills Lesson 5: Marriage and Sexuality: What is the Church Doing in the Bedroom? This talk will explore the teachings of John Paul II and Theology of the Body -- focusing on the human person and the importance of our bodies in communicating. Dr. Kerry and Peter Pound will delve into the language of sexual intercourse, the "wedding vows made flesh". After establishing this groundwork, they will examine



Humanae Vitae and its impact. Finally, they will discuss the biology of fertility awareness techniques as well as their effectiveness and benefits.
